 - 1. Happy, rejoicing group with Jesus**
 - 2. Sad, mournful group with widow and funeral procession. Jews had professional mourners.****

- B. Only son. Very important to the Jews.**
- C. Imagine tenseness of the moment when He touched the bier.**
- D. "And he delivered him to his mother." Loving care of Jesus.**
